Congratulations to our incredible performance troupes who competed at this year's Sunshine Coast Eisteddfod in May. Everyone was blown away by how beautifully you all danced, and how professional you were to both your teachers and other competitors.

Special mention goes to the Intermediate Performance group who received 4th place for Diamonds in the 12&Under Novelty/Cabaret section.

After the holidays, the performance girls will be competing at the Beenleigh Eisteddfod. Sub-Senior/Senior and Combined Performance will compete on Saturday 30th August. Intermediate Performance will compete on Sunday 7th of September. This will be SDA's first time at this competition after it was cancelled at the last minute last year due to a Covid lockdown.

Costumes have now been chosen and samples ordered for students to try on during Costume Measuring Weekend from the 16th and 17th of July. SDA Choreography Competition

The SDA Choreography Competition is back! All students have the opportunity to showcase dances that they have choreographed themselves. These can be done as solos, duos, trios or small groups. It is heaps of fun and there are great prizes to be won (including the opportunity to perform your routine at the annual concert).

The competition will be held on Saturday 20th August (TBC - pending the number of entries) at the York Street (Upstairs) Hall. Our Performance Groups will bring you some of their routines from this year. Competitors pay a \$5 entry fee per group, and it will cost \$2 to come and watch the show. General Information

Second hand shoes and clothing are available at the studio. There are ballet, tap, jazz and character shoes, as well as some leotards, shorts and skirts. If you would like to look at any of the items, please ask your teacher before or after class. The boxes are located in the upstairs hall.

If you have items to sell, please place them in a ziplock bag with your name, the size of the item, and your asking price clearly marked on the front and give them to your teacher. (please note we don't accept tights)

Lost Property is placed in the box in the kitchen in the upstairs hall. We endeavor to return named items to their owners. At the end of each term, all unclaimed items are donated to charity.

Fees for lessons are charged per term and are payable before or at the first lesson of each term. Fees are calculated by dividing the annual fee into 4 equal term payments, therefore there will be no adjustments for shorter- or longer-term periods. There will be classes held on all pupil free days and on some, but not all, public holidays. If your class falls on a day when wer are not holding classes you will receive a credit off your invoice.

Payment by cash or direct deposit is required by week two into the term. Please email your remittance advice as soon as possible and use your invoice number or surname as reference. If you have queries about your account, please direct them to Shilleena outside of class times.

Withdrawing your enrolment must be made in writing to Miss Shilleena otherwise fees will continue to accrue as the student's place is held in the class. If a student withdraws their enrolment before the end of a term, the full term's fees will remain payable.

Classes Missed due to Illness or Holidays (including any quarantine requirements) will not be refunded or credited. Students may take a 'make-up' lesson instead with a comparable class. Make-up lessons are valid up until the end of term 4 then they expire at the end of every year. Please contact Shilleena if you would like to arrange a make-up lesson at anytime.



2022 COSTUME MEASURING

Each year we hold a measuring weekend where all students participating in the end of year concerts must attend to be fitted for their costumes. For most costumes there will be a sizing set that students can try on, however some costumes will require exact measurements. Please wear a leotard/crop top/hot pants so that you can try on any costume easily and also allow us to get accurate measurements. Costume measuring will be held on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th July.

Students are asked to come to the studio in your allocated time slot but if you are unable to attend your allocated session, or need to arrange to come at a different time, please contact Miss Shilleena PRIOR TO THE 16th JULY. You will be fitted for all of your costumes at the one time. Please allow 45 minutes from the start of your timeslot to be fitted as some students have multiple costumes to try on.

It is <u>really important</u> that you attend measuring weekend we must finalise the orders on the 18^{th} to ensure costumes arrive in time for photos and dress rehearsals.

All costume deposits which were charged on your Term 2 Invoice (\$66 for one or two dances, \$220 for 3 or more dances, \$330 for 6 or more dances or Performance) should now have been finalised. We cannot order your costume until this deposit is paid. Additional charges for express shipping will apply if a separate order must be made.
