
TERM 3 NEWSLETTER 2025

Term 2 finishes end of next week, which means dance exams are upon us. Congratulations to our Performance Troupes for their wonderful performances at the Wynnum and Evolution Eisteddfods in May. You all worked so hard, and we could not be prouder of your efforts.

Term 2 will finish on Saturday 28th June, and classes will resume on Monday 14th July. Term 3 sees concert preparation take center stage, however there are no changes to the timetable at this stage. There is also the EKKA public holiday on the 13th August, and your Term 3 invoices have been credited for the classes not being held on that day.

At the end of week 1 in Term 3, all students participating in the concert are required to come to the studio to be fitted for all their costumes. The timetable for costume measuring can be found on page 5 of this newsletter.

Parent Watching Week is also at the end of Term 3 from the 8th to 13th of September. We would love to see our parents come along if they wish, and you'll get a sneak peak of our concert dances.

PERFORMANCE NEWS

Congratulations to our incredible performance troupes who competed at this year's Wynnum Eisteddfod and Evolution Dance Competition in May.

Wynnum saw our Senior Performance troupe received HC for "Oblivion" and our Sub-Senior/Senior troupe receive 1st for "Money". At Evolution, those two dances were awarded third place, and our Intermediate Troupe received third place for "Hot" and a Special Mention for "Le Jazz Hot".

Our dancers are now preparing for the Beenleigh Eisteddfod and Brisbane's first-ever SFD Groups Eisteddfod in August.

Our dancers have been showcasing their skills at recent solo/duo competitions, and we are incredibly proud of their achievements. Caitlin P and Kairi S received second place for their lyrical duo and Olive C (Highly Commended) and Frankie D were competitive in their tap and jazz sections respectively at the Wynnum Eisteddfod. Congratulations also to Aubrey B who placed third with her contemporary solo at Evolution Dance Competition.

2025 CONCERT "ICONIC"

It is time to get excited about our end of year concert - ICONIC.

Costumes have been chosen and samples ordered for students to try on during Costume Measuring Weekend 19th/20th of July. We cannot stress enough how important it is that all students participating in the concert attend their fittings. If you are unavailable, please contact Miss Shilleena to arrange an alternative time PRIOR TO THE 19th OF JULY. Costumes need to be ordered asap to receive them in time for rehearsals and photos. A detailed timetable for costume fittings follows on page 5 of this newsletter.

The concert will be held on Saturday 8^{th} November. Don't forget EVERY STUDENT performs in TWO SHOWS ... an 11:00am matinee and an evening show at 5:00pm.

Each year, we pick a theme for the finale, and this year we are asking students to wear <u>PINK</u>. It can be a costume from this year's show, or any other dancewear/clothing you can move freely in. You do not need to purchase any additional items for finale. The Concert Newsletter will be available in Term 3 listing all the information you need in preparation for concert day.

Studio photographs will be taken by JVE Productions on the $18^{\rm th}$ and $19^{\rm th}$ of October. The timetable for this will be available in Term 3. All photos will be available to purchase online after the shoot as digital downloads.

Limelight Multimedia will film our annual concert and will provide a download link in late November/early December of the performance. Every family participating in the show will receive a download link. The cost for this download will be added to your costume invoices in Term 3.

Live action photos of the performance will also be available to download for an additional fee. Our Concert Newsletter will have more information next term.





GENERAL INFORMATION

Secondhand shoes and clothing are available at the studio. There are ballet, tap, jazz, cabaret and character shoes, as well as some leotards, shorts and skirts. If you would like to look at any of the items, please ask your teacher before or after class. The secondhand items are in the middle of the new sliding cupboards in the kitchen of the upstairs hall.

If you have items to sell, please place them in a ziplock bag with your name, the size of the item, and your asking price clearly marked on the front and give them to your teacher (please note we don't accept tights). Items are left at your own risk and we take no responsibility for items placed for secondhand sale.

Lost Property is placed in the right-hand side of the sliding cupboard in the kitchen in the upstairs hall. We endeavor to return named items to their owners. At the end of each term, all unclaimed items are donated to charity.

Fees for lessons are charged per term. Fees are calculated by dividing the annual fee into 4 equal-term payments, therefore there will be no adjustments for shorter- or longer-term periods. There will be classes held on all pupils' free days and on some, but not all, public holidays. If your class falls on a day when we are not holding classes, you will receive credit off your invoice.

Payment by cash or direct deposit is required by week two of each term. Please email your remittance advice as soon as possible and use your invoice number and surname as reference. If you have queries about your account, please direct them to Shilleena via email or phone.

Withdrawing your enrolment must be made in writing to Miss Shilleena otherwise fees will continue to accrue as the student's place is held in the class. If a student withdraws their enrolment before the end of a term, the full term's fees will remain payable.

Classes Missed due to Illness or Holidays will not be refunded or credited. Students may take a 'make-up' lesson instead with a comparable class. Make-up lessons are valid until the end of term 4 then they expire at the end of every year. After the concert is the perfect time to use any make-up lessons you may have, try out a new class or add a second ballet class – there are heaps of options! Please contact Shilleena if you would like to arrange a make-up lesson at any time.

Unpaid fees attract an administration fee of 20% to all outstanding balances. Prompt settlement of any overdue accounts will prevent the school from spending unnecessary administration time chasing overdue accounts.

Casual classes for adult or advanced classes are \$25 per class. Please give the correct money to your teacher at the start of each lesson.







2025 CHOREOGRAPHY COMPETITION

In August we are holding a Choreography Competition within Shilleena's Dance Academy. It is for all ages and is a great opportunity for students to showcase their choreographic skills! We will have guest judges to make the final decision on the prize winners and give short comments on each routine.

The winner of the choreography competition will be given the opportunity to perform their routine at the end of year concert! All who enter will have a fantastic experience, gain a greater sense of confidence and show everyone your choreographic and dancing talent!!

There is a \$5 entry fee for competitors (one flat fee for solos, duos, trios or small groups) and it will cost \$2 per person (or a donation of your choice) to watch the show. The competition will be held at the York Street Hall on **Saturday 30th August** from 5pm. Doors will open at 4:45pm and payment to watch the show will be taken at the door in cash. As seating is limited, please bring a chair or cushion to sit on. All students, family and friends are welcome!!! Don't forget to bring a few extra dollars to enter our raffle and possibly win some fantastic prizes!

And as an added treat, the Performance Groups will showcase some of their Eisteddfod routines from this year.

Conditions of Entering the Competition:

- The Dance Routine can be any style (jazz, tap, ballet, contemporary, musical theatre, singing, hip hop, acrobatics, novelty, cabaret or mixed genres)
- Each routine must not exceed 4 minutes, 2 minutes is a good guide for younger dancers
- All music must be provided on iPod, phone or can be emailed directly to Miss Shilleena
- Costumes & originality are encouraged
- All props, costumes, music & choreography must be arranged by the dancer(s)
- Smiles are recommended and fun is compulsory!!

Why not get a few friends together and make up a dance to your favourite song?

2025 COSTUME MEASURING WEEKEND

Each year we hold a measuring weekend where all students participating in the end of year concerts must attend to be fitted for their costumes. For most costumes there will be a sizing set that students can try on, however some costumes will require exact measurements. Please wear a leotard OR crop top/hot pants so that you can try on any costume easily and also allow us to get accurate measurements. Costume measuring will be held on Saturday 19^h and Sunday 20th July.

Students are asked to come to the studio in your allocated time slot. You will be fitted for all of your costumes at the one time. Please allow 45 minutes from the start of your timeslot to be fitted as some students have multiple costumes to try on and you may need to wait – however once your costumes have all been fitted you will be free to go.

It is <u>really important</u> that you attend measuring weekend as we must finalise the orders on the 20th to ensure costumes arrive in time for photos and dress rehearsals. If you are unable to attend your allocated session, or need to arrange to come at a different time, please contact Miss Shilleena PRIOR TO THE 19th JULY.

All costume deposits which were charged on your Term 2 Invoice (\$70 for one dance, \$140 for two dances, \$210 for three to five dances and \$420 for six or more dances & all performance troupe dancers) should now have been finalised. We cannot order your costume until this deposit is paid. Additional charges for express shipping will apply if a separate order must be made.

Students in Open Adult Beginner and Intermediate Tap will be sourcing their own costume and will therefore not be fitted this weekend. A look-book will be provided by Miss Alanah, and a photo of your costume needs to be sent to Miss Alanah & Miss Shilleena for approval.

Students in Grades 9 and 10 jazz will be reusing the black long pants from previous years (comm jazz 2023 and jazz tech 2024). Please check if you still have them. If you do not, you will be fitted for a new pair at costume measuring week.

Pre-Elementary (Thursday) and Elementary (Monday) ballet students will be reusing their tutus from last year in this year's concerts. Please remove all decoration from your costume so that we can add new embellishments. New students in these classes will be fitted at costume measuring, and some second-hand white tutus may be available for pre-elementary dancers.

If your only class is Street Jazz, Grade 8 Tap, Grade 9 Tap or Open Tap Technique, you have already been fitted for your costume and do not need to attend fitting weekend.
