## From Miss Shilleena

SDA I am so proud of each and every one of us. We've managed to stick it out through what has been a very uncertain time for everyone. It has been challenging ("Miss Shilleena I'm glitching" was a phrase I never want to hear again) but we managed to get to the other side and now our beautiful dancers can get back to their classes in the studios.

For now, please remember to adhere to the guidelines and restrictions in line with level 2 recommendations from Oueensland Health.

Please do not come to class if you are unwell.

The studios will adhere to a vigorous cleaning program to keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible. All surfaces (door handles and barres in particular) will be disinfected before and after each class.

We will all need to observe social distancing when at the studio. For the Upstairs Studio, dancers will enter through the kitchen door, and exit through the mirrored-door in the centre of the studio. For the Downstairs studio, dancers will enter via the usual door near the male toilets, and exit via the door closest to Cavendish Road onto the grassed area between studios (through the pool gate). For the Third Lower Room, students will need to wait on the concreted area (observing social distancing) until all previous students have left the room before entering.

The kitchen and changing area will reopen in Term 3 pending restrictions easing as advised. Until then, parents are asked to wait in their cars and drop-off and collect their children from the grassed area between the studios while maintaining social distancing.

We are not allowed to have anyone waiting/chatting within the grounds as those numbers count towards our number limits in the studios.

We ask that if at all possible, students do not wait at the studio between classes. Students who must wait between classes may access the Third Lower Room as long as it is not in use and not over the number limits. Please leave the area exactly as you found it.

Please visit the bathroom prior to arriving at the studio where possible. All students will be asked to sanitise their hands upon entry to each class. If you have skin allergies, or are allergic to alcohol-based sanitiser, please bring your own or wash your hands prior to entering the classroom and let myself and your teacher know.

If you are in PBT/Open Pointe or Adult Contemporary, please bring your own yoga matt or towel as we are unable to share equipment at this stage.

I am happy to answer any questions you have regarding our safe return to the studio.

The concert will be held on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> November. <u>Don't forget EVERY STUDENT</u> <u>performs in TWO SHOWS ... an 11:30am</u> <u>matinee and an evening show at 6:30pm.</u>

Each year, we pick a theme for the finale, and this year we are asking students to wear black and red.

Concert DVDs and photos will again be offered this year. Order Forms will be available in Term 3. There will also be studio photographs taken by Tom Baker Photographics on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> of October. The timetable for this will go out in Term 3. These photographs are sold separately on Concert Day and are not available on DVD.

The Concert Newsletter will be available in Term 3 listing all of the information you need in preparation for concert day.

#### **SFD BALLET, TAP & JAZZ EXAMS**

The 2020 SFD ballet, jazz and tap exams will be held across four days in the second week of the June/July school holidays from the 7<sup>th</sup> July to the 10<sup>th</sup> July.

There are extra lessons held prior to each exam and these classes are compulsory for all exam students. We will be going over all examination content as well as rehearsing what will happen on the day so that each student can feel as comfortable and prepared as possible.

This year, the workshops will be held over four days in the first week of the school holidays from 29<sup>th</sup> June to 2<sup>nd</sup> July. There will be two practices per examination being undertaken. There will be a small fee to cover the cost of these additional practices, payable in advance to the SDA bank account.

All ballet students in Grades 2 to 7 must have ballet ribbons sewn onto their ballet shoes, not elastics. There are a number of tutorials available on You Tube if you need guidance. Ribbons can be purchased from any dance shop.
